The challenge with free will is that humans believe it is a license to sin. Sin is the problem of our human condition, and the universal condition of man is that he is dead in sin. Scripture is replete with warnings of the sin problem. It affects everyone, and it has an impact everywhere. Those who claim to live above sin are mistaken.
